



Scholarship for Academic Excellence and Service

The scholarship is presented to a graduating student who has met the following criteria:

- Must have been on the Honour Roll for the last 2 years
- Nominee has participated in extracurricular/volunteer activities at school.
- Has participated in volunteer activities in the community

Selection Process:

A staff advisor will share the information about student academic eligibility for the scholarship and the list of eligible candidates with the grade 12 students.

Eligible candidates must provide the staff advisor with a written summary of their extra curricular and volunteer activities, within the school and community.

The method of sharing the summaries with the grade 12 students is left to the discretion of the staff advisor.

Upon review of the candidates' information, the grade 12 students will vote by secret ballot.

The results will be tabulated by the staff advisor

The name of the recipient will be forwarded to the secretary-treasurer at the division office.

The recipient will not be announced until the award is presented.

Scholarship for Academic Diligence

The scholarship is presented to a student who, irrespective of ability, has diligently pursued their studies through the high school years and has demonstrated a commitment to learning.

The scholarship for Commitment to Learning is determined through peer selection and presented to a student who meets the following criteria:

- Irrespective of ability, this student has demonstrated a commitment to learning through their high school career (Grade 9 – Grade 12)

Selection Process

Each grade 12 student may nominate one student they believe to be deserving of this scholarship.

All students are awarded 3 votes and will rank their selections first, second and third.

The results are tabulated by the staff advisor

The name of the recipient will be forwarded to the Secretary-Treasurer/CFO at the division office.

The recipient's name will not be announced until the award is presented.
