



The School Psychologist is a member of the School Support Team—Once a student concern is identified that goes beyond the typical supports provided by the In-School Support team, consultation with the School Psychologist begins.

To access the direct services of a School Psychologist, a formal written referral and parent/guardian informed consent is required. All requests for services will be coordinated and prioritized at the school level between the School Psychologist, Resource Teacher, Guidance Counsellor and Principal/Vice Principal.
