## **MANITOBA'S K TO 12 EDUCATION ACTION PLAN**

Manitoba Education held virtual school leader sessions on April 22 and 25, 2022.

PRSD's Manitoba Education Action Plan leadership team, Terry Osiowy, Ron Sugden, Mary Reimer, Marc Tellier, Crystal Millar-Courchene, and Cecile Affleck will be meeting May 11, 2022, to continue our discussions regarding divisional actions for the communication and implementation of this provincial education plan.

## **FRAMEWORK FOR LEARNING SESSION REPORT – MANITOBA EDUCATION**

Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning are offering introductory sessions to the Framework for Learning in both English and French for school leaders. These introductory sessions will build awareness and shared understandings of this provincial initiative to support their work as instructional leaders.

PRSD school leaders have been asked to register and participate in two different sessions; the first an introduction to the Framework for Learning and the second an information session on the provincial Global Competencies.

## **ÉCOLE ST. EUSTACHE PROFESSIONAL STAFF ADJUSTMENT - 2022-2023**

The Superintendent/CEO reported that Ecole St. Eustache will continue with single graded classes for the 2022-2023 school year. This staffing adjustment of an additional 1.0 FTE was made possible by finding some 2022-2023 staffing efficiencies across the system and by the Superintendent/CEO releasing some contingency staffing to ESE for the 2022-2023.

### **BILL 3 - THE PUBLIC SERVICES ACT**

The Superintendent/CEO provided the Board with a letter from Dana Rudy, Deputy Minister of Education and Early Childhood Learning regarding Bill 3 - The Public Services Act which was proclaimed and came into force on February 26, 2022.

As per the PSA, each public service employer is to establish a code of conduct and action plan which can include all existing documents that align with the values of the PSA.

The Superintendent/CEO will work with the Human Resources Manager and will bring forward a Bill 3 - The Public Services Act Administrative Procedure to the Board in June 2022.

#### **Highlighted Motions:**

**THAT** based on a petition signed by the parents or guardians of at least 75% of the pupils in the school, we approved the daily saying of the Lord's Prayer at Hutterian Colony School – Huron Colony for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year.

**THAT** the request of the Prairie Rose Teachers' Association, that the President of the Association for the 2022/2023 school year, Melissa Benner, be seconded from the Division on a 0.5 FTE basis be approved, subject to the Division being reimbursed by the Association for all salary and benefit costs for the period of the secondment, to details of the release time being agreed upon between the Superintendent/CEO, the affected principal, and Melissa Benner, and that upon the return of the teacher to the Division, the teacher shall be reinstated in the same or comparable position at the school.

**THAT**, as agreed at the September 13, 2021, Committee-of-the-Whole meeting, the Board approve the Agreement in committee relating to the CUPE Local 4701 Unit A and Unit B July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2022, Collective Agreement.
