Interactive/Television for 2020-2021 – Staffing Implications

The Superintendent/CEO shared the following Interactive Television/On-Line updates for 2020-2021.

1. Carman Collegiate, Elm Creek School, Miami School, St. Paul's Collegiate, and St. Laurent School have all completed and submitted their 2020-2021 course registration numbers to PRSD. PRSD will now determine which courses will be delivered through the ITV/On-Line centralized delivery model in 2020-2021.
2. ITV/On-Line courses will be delivered from a centralized location, just as all HCS courses are delivered from the HCS administration office in Elie, Manitoba. Board was informed that Carman Collegiate will be designated as the site of ITV/On-Line course delivery for PRSD.
3. Upon final selection of ITV/On-Line courses, PRSD will post/advertise for up to 2 ITV/On-Line teaching positions for internal and external competitions.
4. The centralized ITV/On-Line course delivery model may require staffing adjustments at all community high schools.

PRSD Remote Learning Data

The Assistant Superintendent shared a report on COVID-19 remote learning in PRSD schools. The school by school reports included a break down on how each school is providing remote learning opportunities to their students, the required technology support each school has provided to students and families to support remote learning, and how the principals and their respective staffs are communicating and planning during this “emergency” remote learning environment.

Both the Superintendent/CEO and the Assistant Superintendent commended PRSD staff for their exceptional work, efforts, and commitment to our students and families as they adjust their instructional and assessment practices to a remote learning environment during the unprecedented COVID-19 emergency.
